Current FACE work with the Academy of Culinary Arts, 'Chefs Adopt a School' Project, is showing great potential at offering on-farm cooking as part of a visit to a farm. How can we set this experience up for schools?

This Cookery seminar is an opportunity for farmers, teachers and outdoor educators to learn more from the experts about developing and delivering practical curriculum-linked cookery sessions on a real farm, although the practical nature of the day means the methodology can be used in school too by teachers or visiting farmers. At the end of the training, participants should feel confident about their understanding of how to deliver fun, informative and educational cookery sessions.

The day will include demonstrations and practical breadmaking and preparing soups with children. In the afternoon a farm tour (please bring appropriate clothing, wellies), to look at links to farm visits and practical suggestions for activities will be included. All underpinned with a dose of curriculum ideas and links. FACE is delighted to be working with Chef Idris Caldora from Chefs Adopt a School Project.
