

Suggested Wordings to use in your Will

These suggested wordings can be incorporated into a new Will or can be added by means of a codicil to an existing one. Please feel free to give your chosen wording to your solicitor or Will-writer.

For the whole residue of an estate:

“Subject to the payment of my just debts, funeral and testamentary expenses and any legacies, I give all the residue of my estate, both real and personal, to Farming & Countryside Education (UK charity no.1108241), of Stoneleigh Park, Warwickshire CV8 2LG. The receipt of the Treasurer, or other authorised officer, shall be sufficient discharge of the same.”

For a share in the residue of an estate:

“Subject to the payment of my just debts, funeral and testamentary expenses and any legacies, I give all the residue of my estate, both real and personal, to and equally between the followingAs to one part thereof to Farming & Countryside Education (UK charity no.1108241), of Stoneleigh Park, Warwickshire CV8 2LG. The receipt of the Treasurer, or other authorised officer, shall be sufficient discharge of the same.”

For a cash sum:

“I give to Farming & Countryside Education (UK charity no.1108241), of Stoneleigh Park, Warwickshire CV8 2LG, the sum of £_____ free of all taxes and duties and linked to the retail price index from today and I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer, or other authorised officer, shall be sufficient discharge of the same.”

For a specific item:

“I give to Farming & Countryside Education (UK charity no.1108241), of Stoneleigh Park, Warwickshire CV8 2LG free of taxes and duties (*a clear description of the item to be given*) for its general purposes and I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer, or other authorised officer, shall be sufficient discharge of the same.”
